Update: District Project: Haiti

On March 10-14 the Zonta Club of Cape Girardeau took a dental team with a combined medical crew to the Haitian American Caucus School in Croix des Bouquets. On Saturday and Sunday mostly adults in the community were seen. On Monday, school was in session, and the school children and teachers were in the clinic. Dental kits and worming tablets were distributed to all the school children. In total, the team saw over 800 people with extractions, cleanings, reading glasses fitted, and over 410 medical patients seen. The school population is much healthier since the project began in 2012.
